# Ukrainian government bodies responsible for EE and RES

**Ministry of Regional Development, Construction and Housing of Ukraine  
(Minregion) –**

ensures the development of the state policy in the area of EE and RES

**State Agency on Energy Efficiency and Energy Saving of Ukraine (SAEE) –**

implements the state policy in the area of EE and RES

Cooperation with INOGATE : June 2015 to January 2016 (CWP.08/12.UA)

- Introduction of EU energy labelling and ecodesign into the legislation of Ukraine
- Support of the VII International Investment Business Forum on EE and RES

# Planning of works on Introduction of energy labelling and ecodesign in Ukraine

**Action Plan on implementation of Association agreement between the EU and Ukraine**  
(Government Resolution # 847-p of September 17, 2014)

**Implementation plan of certain EU legislative acts on Ecodesign** (Government Resolution # 475-p of May 14, 2015)

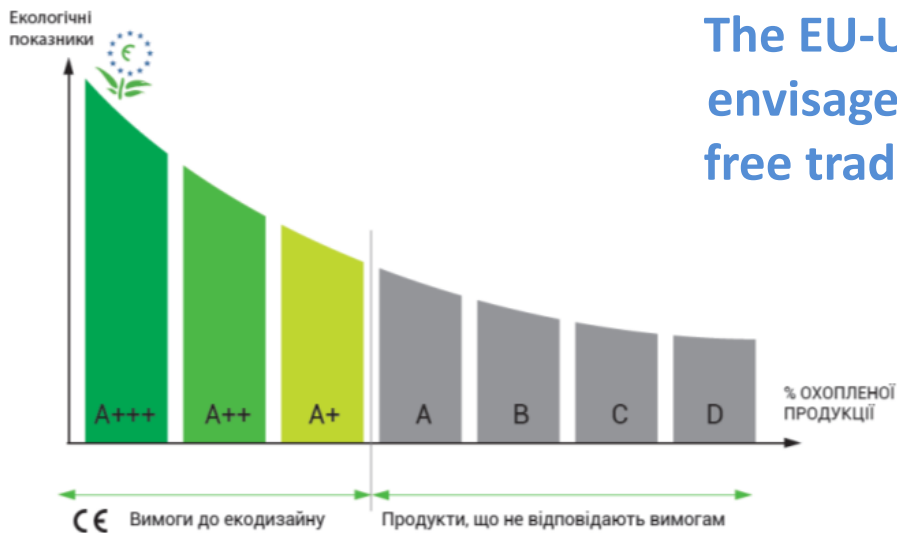
**Implementation plan of certain EU legislative acts on Energy Labelling**  
(Government Resolution # 499-p of May 20, 2015)

**Development strategy of the technical regulation system up to 2020**  
(Government Resolution #844-p of August 19, 2015)  
Includes a full list of EU regulations on ecodesign and energy labelling

# Outcomes and Plans of works on Introduction of energy labelling and ecodesign

The EU-Ukraine Association Agreement envisages creation of a deep and comprehensive free trade area (DCFTA)

Ecodesign and energy labelling are DCFTA elements



## 2013-2015 (achieved):

- Introduction of energy labelling Directive
- Introduction of Regulations on energy labelling for
  - Refrigerators; Washing machines
  - Lamps and luminaries; Dishwashers

## 2016-2017 (plans):

- Transposition of EU Ecodesign Directive into the national legislation
- Introduction of ecodesign regulations
- Introduction of energy labelling regulations



# Assistance of INOGATE in implementation of the EU acts on energy labelling and ecodesign

- Improvement of 5 draft technical regulations on energy labelling
- Translation of current technical regulations on energy labelling for official evaluation by the EC
- Assistance to the Agency in drafting a legal document transposing EU Directive 2009/125/EC on ecodesign
- Assistance to the Agency in transposition of EC Regulations on ecodesign into Ukrainian legislation: priority, structure and content
- Translation of 10 EC Regulations on ecodesign for different energy-related products
- Preparation of the list of European harmonised standards for introduction of energy labelling and ecodesign in Ukraine
- Assistance to the Agency in organisation of the VII International Investment Business Forum on EE and RES
- Raising of awareness on energy labelling and ecodesign

# Outcomes of introduction of technical regulations on energy labelling and ecodesign with the assistance of INOGATE

## Introduction of ecodesign requirements in Ukraine – November 2017

- Fulfillment of the requirements of the EU-Ukraine Association Agreement
- Increasing energy independence of the country
- Raising awareness among population
- Reducing customers' energy bills
- Reducing environmental impact



### *E.g.: energy labelling and ecodesign in the EU:*

- *19% savings as compared with conventional energy consumption regime*
- *Half of target EE indicator of 20% by 2020*
- *Reducing dependency on energy import by 23% for natural gas and by 37% for coal*
- *Savings of 100 billion euros for end consumers by reducing energy bills by 2020*
